6.1	Progression, Determination and Classification of Results: Postgraduate Master's Programmes	<i>All programmes:</i> Candidates who fail a module at initial attempt and referral attempt are eligible for an internal repeat only.
6.4	Progression, Determination and Classification of Results: Postgraduate Master's Programmes	<i>All programmes:</i> The marks will be capped at component level.

	Existing University Regulation	Approved Exemption
6.4	Progression, Determination and Classification of Results: Postgraduate Master's Programmes	<i>All programmes:</i> Candidates who fail a module or modules at initial attempt, and referral attempt, are eligible for a partial internal repeat of the failed components or module(s) only, to be undertaken at the next available opportunity.

Additional Requirements

The clause(s) listed below describe where an additional requirement to the General Regulations exists.

Programme Title	Additional Requirement
<i>All programmes</i>	Continuation on the programme is subject to specific health requirements (consistent with the provisions of the Equality Act 2010). Candidates are required to inform the Faculty of any health problems throughout their period of enrolment, relevant to their future employment as a professional.
<i>All programmes</i>	A candidate will be deemed to have failed the programme, without the right of re-entry, in exceptional circumstances where there is gross misconduct or a serious breach of the Code of Conduct of the British Psychological Society.
<i>All programmes</i>	A candidate will be deemed to have failed the programme, without the right of re-entry, if they have failed to complete all elements of summative assessment to a satisfactory standard within 5 years of first registration, or by such a date as will have been agreed by the Board of Examiners.

These regulations should be read in conjunction with the programme specification.
